OUR EASTER PROCLAMATION – Based on 1 Corinthians 15 and Romans 8

Please join in on the BOLD words.

In the Name of the Father, and of the † Son, and of the Holy Spirit. *Amen.* Alleluia! Christ is risen. *He is risen indeed.* Alleluia!

If Christ is not risen, nothing matters. Our preaching is then useless and our faith, too. We are false witnesses about God, for we have testified that God raised Christ Jesus from the dead. We are still in our sins and those who have died are as dead as ever.

You cancel Easter...you eliminate the Resurrection...you erase the fact that Jesus rose from the dead...and there's not a one of us who would be here this morning....You and I would be the most pitied, pathetic, pile of people who ever lived on this earth.

But – if Christ is risen, nothing else matters. Though in Adam all may have died, in Christ all will then be made alive. He will destroy every dominion, power, and authority and put every enemy under his feet. LESSON FROM GOD'S WORD Luke 24:36-49 and 1 John 1:1-4

Jesus Appears to His Disciples Easter Sunday Evening Luke 24:36-49

³⁶ As they [Jesus' disciples] were talking about these things, Jesus himself stood among them, and said to them, "Peace to you!" ³⁷ But they were startled and frightened and thought they saw a spirit [a ghost]. ³⁸ And he said to them, "Why are you troubled, and why do doubts arise in your hearts? ³⁹ See my hands and my feet, that it is I myself. Touch me, and see. For a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have." ⁴⁰ And when he had said this, he showed them his hands and his feet. ⁴¹ And while they still disbelieved for joy and were marveling, he said to them, "Have you anything here to eat?" ⁴² They gave him a piece of broiled fish, ⁴³ and he took it and ate before them.

⁴⁴ Then he said to them, "These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you, that everything written about me in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms must be fulfilled." ⁴⁵ Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures, ⁴⁶ and said to them, "Thus it is written, that the Christ should suffer and on the third day rise from the dead, ⁴⁷ and that repentance for the forgiveness of sins should be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. ⁴⁸ You are witnesses of these things. ⁴⁹ And behold, I am sending the promise of my Father upon you. But stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high."

Regarding Holy Communion:

The Lord's Supper, or Holy Communion, is celebrated here at Peace in the confession and glad confidence that, as He says, our Lord gives into our mouths not only bread and wine but His very body and blood to eat and to drink for the forgiveness of sins and to strengthen our union with Him and with one another.

Our congregation believes that participating in the Lord's Supper acts as a statement that those communing agree with everything our church body teaches. Out of loving care and concern, we want to do all that we can to make sure those who participate in our Communion celebration don't violate their own conscience or a public confession of faith made through another church body by making that joint statement of faith with us.

For that reason, we ask those who don't know and agree with the teachings of The Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod to not commune today. If you'd like to come forward during Communion to receive a blessing from Pastor but not participate by taking the bread and wine, please do so. You may indicate this choice by folding your hands during the distribution.

If for any reason you wish to stay in your seat during Communion, that's okay, too. You won't be alone. Anyone wishing to have the bread and wine brought to their seat, perhaps because of a physical or other challenge, may speak to Pastor or another church member before the service.
